Fire! Fire!

English

This term pupils will be using the text **Vlad and the Great Fire of London**. They will be focusing on using adjectives to describe the scenes of the Great Fire of London and writing diaries as Vlad.

Maths

This term pupils will be introduced to multiplication, division and fractions. Children can access Times Table Rockstars at home to support their learning.

Science

This term pupils will link their knowledge of properties of materials with explaining why the fire spread and the impact that houses being made from wood had on the spread of the fire.

History

Children will be learning about the Great Fire of London and how it had an impact on present day London. They will sequence the events of the fire and look at how far the fire spread.

Art/DT

In DT the children will learn about free standing structures and how they are built before designing and creating their own.

Music

In music, all the learning is focused around one song: Round And Round, a Bossa Nova Latin style. Pupil will be singing as well as using glockenspiels. We will also be learning a song to help remember the sequence of events during the Great Fire of London.

Computing

Pupils will be introduced to Robotics focusing on Bee-Bot. We will be recognising and naming the buttons and symbols, planning and entering a sequence of commands, using directional language and then debugging sequences for errors. Pupils will then create their own challenges for themselves to test different sequences.

R.E.

For this term our key question is 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?'. We will discuss which communities we belong to and link this to how religious people belong to communities.

P.E.

The focus for this term will be on dance and movement.

Personal Development

This term the focus is on Pride, Aspirations and Achievements. Pupils will focus on how to show pride and celebrate achievements they have made, and how to celebrate achievements of others.
